SUBJECT: Submittal of bid opening report for 2014-15 Micro Surfacing, Los Osos, to award the subject contract to Telfer Highway Technologies, the lowest responsible bidder, in the amount of \$1,103,955. District 2.

### **RECOMMENDATION**

In accordance with applicable State Law, it is recommended that the Board:

1. Award the subject contract (No. 300528) for the Base bid plus additives 1, 3, and 4 to Telfer Highway Technologies, the lowest responsible bidder, at \$1,053,955; and
2. Authorize the Public Works Director or his designee to approve change orders for a contingency amount up to \$50,000 for a final total construction amount of \$1,103,955.

### **DISCUSSION**

The Los Osos micro surfacing contract is in coordination with the previously approved asphalt overlay project in Los Osos to address the road system now that the wastewater collection system construction has been completed. The work is necessary to rehabilitate residential streets and halt further deterioration of existing pavements. This contract provides for micro-surfacing on 30 miles within the community. The contract also includes additive bid items which were intended to be included in the contract, if the bids were favorable, for the Vista De Oro Estates and Bayridge Estates subdivisions, as well as the El Moro bike path for specialized color seal coat and South Bay Boulevard road shoulders. In addition, a separate project to upgrade the existing ADA ramps will precede the micro surfacing to comply with Federal regulations.

In accordance with direction from your Board, bids for the subject contract were opened on Thursday, May 21, 2015.

Four bids were received. They are as follows:

Base bid includes 30 miles of street impacted by the collection system construction.

Additive 1 includes 1.5 miles of streets in the Vista Del Mar neighborhood; outside the collection system work.

Additive 2 includes 3 miles of streets in the Bayridge Estates tract; outside the collection system work.

Additive 3 includes the existing El Moro Bikeway which is in need of maintenance.

Additive 4 includes the road shoulders of South Bay Boulevard from Los Osos Valley Road to Santa Ysabel Avenue, which is in need of maintenance.

The low bid came in within 1% of the Engineer's Estimate for the base bid, and we have reviewed the submittal from Telfer Highway Technologies and verified that they are the lowest responsive, responsible bidder. The bid prices were also favorable for the additional project sites, and it is therefore recommended that the Board award the additive bid items, with the exception of the Bayridge Estates subdivision, additive bid item 2. The existing sewer collection system constructed with the Bayridge Estates subdivision is currently undergoing repairs, so it is recommended that this additive bid item 2 not be awarded with the contract. The total of the base and additive bid items, excluding additive bid 2, is 1,053,955.00. The Bayridge Estates subdivision will be done in subsequent micro surfacing contract.

**OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT**

Various utility companies have been contacted including the Los Osos Community Services District and the Golden State Water Company in consideration of project impacts to their facilities.

Staff has reviewed the pavement treatments and subsequent traffic striping with the Los Osos Community Advisory Council.

The County Clerk formally processes the bid openings.

The County Environmental Coordinator has reviewed the project and determined that it is exempt from CEQA.

## **FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS**

This is a Pavement Management project budgeted in the Road Fund FY 2014-15 at \$1,278,203. The total project costs are estimated at \$1,360,478. Funding for the project will come from the Road Fund - Pavement Management Program. Estimated cost increase of \$82,275 will be funded from the Road Fund - Pavement Management Program FY 2015-16. No budget adjustment is necessary.

Please see Exhibit "A" for an estimated cost breakdown of the project.

## **RESULTS**

The immediate result of the recommended action will be the construction of this project, which will improve the road for the safety of the motoring public. This, in turn, will result in a safer, more livable community.
