



Subject: I would like to request a hearing on this matter.

In your letter dated June 19, 2015, your office described a request by the Los Osos Community Services District for a Minor Use permit/Coastal Development Permit to allow for the installation of an unmanned wireless communications facility consisting of multiple antennas, radio heads, raycaps, equipment pads, electrical meter and chain link fence. These installations are directly adjacent to my property, and would have serious economic and functional impacts to my interests. I would like to request a hearing on this matter.

At the hearing I will describe the impacts of these installations and will be asking that the permit be withheld until these impacts have been studied and rectified and/or alternate site locations be explored. If no such alternatives are identified, then I would expect to be fully compensated for the financial and functional impacts of these installations, and that the permit not be issued until these compensations have been agreed to.
