SUBJECT: Submittal of a resolution establishing changes to the Traffic Regulation Codes for parking restrictions on Cave Landing Road, Avila Beach; and to establish angled parking and disabled person parking on Carrillo Street, Nipomo and K Street, San Miguel. Districts 1, 3 and 4.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board adopt the attached resolution establishing changes to the Traffic Regulation Codes for parking restrictions on Cave Landing Road, Avila Beach; and to establish angled parking and disabled person parking on Carrillo Street in Nipomo and K Street in San Miguel.

DISCUSSION

The Department of Public Works received requests for parking restrictions or modifications at the following locations:

Cave Landing Road, Avila Beach –

Public Works met with Cal Fire and CHP following a multi-incident day when Cal Fire could not access the Cave Landing Road parking lot in order to respond to an emergency at the beach. Vehicles were parked along Cave Landing Road in the existing no parking zone; however, CHP did not have the authority to tow vehicles. The attached resolution will modify the no parking zone on Cave Landing Road to a tow away zone. In addition, the resolution will add an additional 500 feet of no parking on the south side of the road where there is insufficient shoulders for vehicles to park off the pavement.

K Street, San Miguel -

Public Works recently completed expansion of the K Street Park 'n Ride Lot located at the southwesterly corner of K Street and 10th Street. The project provides for a total of 38 parking stalls. The attached resolution will extend the angled parking to the intersection of 9th Street.

Carrillo Street, Nipomo –

Public Works recently completed construction of the Olde Towne Nipomo Park and Ride Lot on Carrillo Street east of Tefft Street. The project is the culmination of cooperation between the Olde Towne Nipomo Association, County District 4 Supervisor's Office, County Public Works, County General Services, San Luis Obispo Council of Governments (SLOCOG), and many others. The project provides 19 parking spaces, an ADA van accessible space, sidewalks, and curb ramps. The attached resolution will establish angled parking and disabled person parking space on the northeasterly side of Carrillo Street between Tefft Street and Dana Street in Nipomo.

Staff recommends your Board adopt the attached resolution to establish parking regulations at these locations.

Adoption of these regulations does not require a public hearing.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT

The California Highway Patrol and the Sheriff's Department will enforce these restrictions, once posted. The affected Advisory Councils have been notified of these proposed actions.

San Luis Obispo Council of Governments provided funding for the expansion of the Park n Ride Lots.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

Placement of signs is estimated to cost approximately \$1,000. This is within the Road Fund's budgeted amount for this activity.

RESULTS

Adoption of this Resolution will enhance County road safety and operations thus improving community livability.
