SUBJECT: Submittal of a resolution authorizing execution of notice of completion and acceptance for the construction of the 2014-15 Chip Seal, Various Roads, San Luis Obispo County. Districts 1, 3 and 5.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board adopt the attached resolution, which authorizes the execution of a notice of completion and acceptance for the construction of the 2014-15 Chip Seal, Various Roads, San Luis Obispo County (Contract No. 245R12B618).

DISCUSSION

The subject contract was awarded to Telfer Highway Technologies, on August 12, 2014 in the amount of \$1,134,791 and was constructed within the allowable working days.

The project consisted of chip sealing 38 miles of various County maintained asphalt concrete roadways as shown on the vicinity maps. The chip seal contract is part of the Department of Public Works Annual Maintenance Program, which provides for the resurfacing of existing paved roads to extend the pavement service life. With the exception of site No. 6, all the road segments that were resurfaced are in the County's Pavement Management System. Site No. 6 provides access to the Salinas Dam and was included at the request of the Utilities Division.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT

There are no other agencies involved in this matter.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

This is a multi-year Pavement Management Program project. The total project costs are estimated at \$1,252,377. Funding for the project comes from the Road Fund - Pavement Management Program in the amount of \$1,213,210 and Special District – Salinas Dam in the amount of \$39,168.

Estimated Road Fund savings of \$232,314 resulting from construction costs savings will be applied to the FY 2015/16 Pavement Management Program. No budget adjustment is necessary.

A final report of actual project costs will be filed with the clerk after any and all claims, disputes and adjustments have been resolved. We do not anticipate the final project cost to differ materially from the current estimated total. Five percent (5%) of total contractor payments are held by the County and released only after meeting the legal holding period after the Notice of Completion is filed.

Please see Exhibit "A" for an estimated cost breakdown of the project.

RESULTS

By taking the recommended action, the Board will cause the legal notice of completion for this construction contract to be recorded, and start the period of time during which liens can be filed by subcontractors against the prime contractor.
