SUBJECT: Hearing to consider a resolution authorizing the levy and collection of annual assessments for Tract 1747 Streetlight Assessment District (Nipomo) for Fiscal Year 2015-16. Hearing continued from July 21, 2015. District 4.

### **RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the Board:

1. Conduct public hearing and amend Engineer's Annual Levy Report, if necessary;
2. Adopt the attached resolution which would authorize the levy and collection of annual assessments for Tract 1747 Streetlight Assessment District for Fiscal Year 2015-16; and
3. Direct the Clerk to file the approved resolution and exhibit with the County Auditor/Controller/Treasurer/Tax Collector (ACTT) immediately.

### **DISCUSSION**

Tract 1747 is a residential lot subdivision at the northeasterly corner of Thompson Avenue and Chestnut Street in Nipomo. A streetlight assessment was established in 2013 for maintenance and operation of 16 existing streetlights.

The Public Works Department is requesting continuance of the policy of collecting annual assessments on the tax roll. This collection procedure is authorized per Section 22620 et seq. of the Streets and Highways Code and 6061 of the Government Code.

The annual street lighting assessment for fiscal year 2015-16 for Tract 1747 Streetlight Assessment District, is established at \$53.60 per Assessor's Parcel Number.

On July 7, 2015, the Board took action to set a public hearing on this item on July 21, 2015. However, a resolution other than the one described in the July 7 board package was inadvertently attached to that July 7 board package. That incorrect resolution (i.e. Resolution No. 2015-170) has not been acted upon, and has not been published. (The resolution attached to today's Board package formally rescinds Resolution No. 2015-170.)

On July 21, 2015 the Board continued the item to this date, and passed a proper resolution of intention setting the public hearing for today's date (i.e. August 11, 2015). The County Clerk has properly published said resolution and the public noticing requirements for today's hearing have been met.

### **OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT**

The ACTT's Office collects the charges and places them on the property tax bills. County Counsel has reviewed the subject resolution and approved it as to legal form and effect. The Clerk publishes the notice of the hearing Pursuant to Section 22629 of the Streets and Highway Code, the County Auditor has consented to the continuance of this public hearing to August 11, 2015.

### **FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS**

The recommended action will generate approximately \$8,000 in revenue which, other than interest, will be the sole source of 2015-16 revenue in Nipomo Lighting District, Tract 1747 Streetlight Assessment District.

### **RESULTS**

The recommended action will result in the continuation of the County's past practice of collecting certain special district's annual assessments on the property tax bills. The revenue funds the cost of the health and safety issues that help to maintain the quality of life in these communities.
