DISCUSSION

The mission of the Nipomo Chamber of Commerce is to promote the civic, economic, agricultural, educational and social welfare of Nipomo. In pursuit of those goals, the organization sponsors many community events throughout the year. One such event is the October Festival being held on October 10th and 11th, 2015 at Nipomo Community Park. The Festival provides networking opportunities for not only the business and service organizations but also brings together these organizations for the local residents to have access to. The event is free to the public.

The \$2,000 in County funds will be used towards expenses associated with holding the October 10th and 11th, 2015 event. Expenses include but are not limited to park rental fees, generator, portable toilets, trash containers/collections, or advertising.
