RE: Support for the Expand San Miguel Community Park Project That Includes a Multi-use Ball Field


Dear Madams and Sirs,

AYSO Region 741 (Paso Robles) supports your Parks and Recreation Department's plan to expand San Miguel Community Park to include a multi-use sports field.


One third of San Miguel's citizens are under the age of 18, which is more children per capita than any other community in our County. Another third or more are parents of these children, yet San Miguel has no sports fields or other facilities for children and families to participate in team sports. The benefits of team sports for children are well documented and include healthier bodies, higher IQ's, more confidence and emotional control. Kids learn important life skills such as hard work, persistence, respect, creative decision making and strategic thinking. In addition, a coach can be one of the most influential people in a child's life and are often mentors to the children they coach. The proposed plan to Expand San Miguel Community Park includes a multi-use ball field will enable San Miguel's children to play team sports and experience these benefits.

AYSO Paso Robles Region 741 has children from San Miguel playing on our teams and we are certain there are many others that would like to play but can't because of the 10 miles distance to the closest soccer fields in Paso Robles. As superintendent of San Miguel Joint Union School District, I wish to reiterate my offer to make the already established athletic fields on the property of Lillian Larsen School available to the community. We again offer the alternative using county resources to assist with watering our existing fields during the extreme drought and provide security/supervision after school in the evenings and on weekends. I believe, as I stated publicly in a recent community forum you hosted, that sharing of an existing field to maximize its utility is a far more responsible, fiscally prudent use of resources than the proposed closure of K Street and the removal of some of the most beautiful mature shade trees in San Miguel.

Lillian Larsen Elementary School has a larger soccer field than the one being proposed for development at our local park on K Street. I would like to assure you that there will be access to this field by the public and that my proposal to you is not outside the trends of use of most public schools in the State of California, which already implement this practice of shared recreational community access.

Re: County of San Luis Obispo, Vacation and Closure of K Street, San Miguel

Honorable Supervisors:

The San Miguel Community Services District Board of Directors is formally requesting the Board of Supervisors reject the proposed vacation and closure of K Street in the community of San Miguel until the following questions and issues of concern have been completely addressed and resolved:

- 1) All feasible park design alternatives, such as retaining K Street as an open public street and roadway, has been evaluated in a documented environmental impact assessment and provided for public review and comment.
- 2) The elimination of existing mature trees at the present park be significantly reduced in terms of numbers of trees to be cut-down and lost for shading purposes.
- 3) The park design and environmental review documents assess a significant increase in parking lot, spaces or areas to be provided for the planned park improvements.
- 4) The widening and improvements be planned for the existing alleyway, planned street improvements to all park boundaries, especially the north and south sides adjoining the present park site.
- 5) The single-family residence located at the southeasterly edge of the park should be acquired and included with the park design and planned improvements.
- 6) Planned pedestrian access and walkways should be adequately addressed in the preliminary and final park designs, since there are likely to be a number of children, youths and parents who will walk to the park.
