Dear Supervisors,

Please expedite your collective reply on the SLO County response that is being awaited by Santa Barbara and Ventura Counties, and join with them to assess the benefits of community choice. There will not be a better opportunity, and the county cannot afford to let it pass.

If SLO county is forced to do this study at a later date on it's own, it will cost significantly more than the collective study. It defrays the fixed costs of the study among three counties. The cooperative study allows the counties together to potentially plan out projects of a size and scale that none of them could do individually. Doing it later is clearly not a financially viable option. It really is now or never for this project.

There is no good reason for the rate-payers to subsidize PG&E's blunders. How large a solar project could have been done for the same cost as what has been spent and was projected to be spent on the Diablo Canyon relicensing blunder that both the Coastal Commission and PUG shot down? Would we even have needed the power from the reactor if that large a project was built in the county to supply the counties needs? PG&E has no incentive to raise rates; it will just increase the cost and pass those costs on. It has also denied a request to implement a microgrid at Cal Poly. Here we have a University with great Engineering talent, who want to invest in their school and community, and PG&E just didn't see the need? How is "no thanks, not interested" even possible in that context?

Community Choice Energy can solve this problem for SLO county as it already has in counties to the north. This is not some pie in the sky hopeful but remote possibility. There are real cities and counties making money producing their own power. If SLO county does not want to loose out business to other counties, which it will when the electricity rates are eventually raised to pay for PG&E's mistakes, then it must undertake the study to see what benefits might be gained.

It is certain that Clean Energy will ultimately be cheaper. It has to be, since in the long run the fuel cost rules out fossil fuels, and the combined costs of nuclear are not even as good as that. The longer

we're forced to pay for the sources, the more we will pay in total, indefinitely. It is time and more than time to get going on what we have known for decades that we must do. At two dollars per gallon for gasoline, there was not enough incentive, and it was understandable to lag the investment. However, four dollar a gallon gasoline has been a looming threat for a decade now, and an actual threat this year and parts of last year.

This study is one we can neither afford to pass on or to wait on. We must do it. We must do it now. Anyone who does not aggressively pursue this now will have hard questions to answer, and a tough uphill battle in the face of those questions in the next election, if this opportunity is simply allowed to expire without any action.

Dear Supervisors,

Please expedite your collective reply on the SLO County response that is being awaited by Santa Barbara and Ventura Counties, and join with them to assess the benefits of community choice. There will not be a better opportunity, and the county cannot afford to let it pass.

If SLO county is forced to do this study at a later date on it's own, it will cost significantly more than the collective study. It defrays the fixed costs of the study among three counties. The cooperative study allows the counties together to potentially plan out projects of a size and scale that none of them could do individually. Doing it later is clearly not a financially viable option. It really is now or never for this project.

There is no good reason for the rate-payers to subsidize PG&E's blunders. How large a solar project could have been done for the same cost as what has been spent and was projected to be spent on the Diablo Canyon relicensing blunder that both the Coastal Commission and PUG shot down? Would we even have needed the power from the reactor if that large a project was built in the county to supply the counties needs? PG&E has no incentive to raise rates; it will just increase the cost and pass those costs on. It has also denied a request to implement a microgrid at Cal Poly. Here we have a University with great Engineering talent, who want to invest in their school and community, and PG&E just didn't see the need? How is "no thanks, not interested" even possible in that context?

Community Choice Energy can solve this problem for SLO county as it already has in counties to the north. This is not some pie in the sky hopeful but remote possibility. There are real cities and counties making money producing their own power. If SLO county does not want to loose out business to other counties, which it will when the electricity rates are eventually raised to pay for PG&E's mistakes, then it must undertake the study to see what benefits might be gained.

It is certain that Clean Energy will ultimately be cheaper. It has to be, since in the long run the fuel cost rules out fossil fuels, and the combined costs of nuclear are not even as good as that. The longer we're forced to pay for the sources, the more we will pay in total, indefinitely. It is time and more than time to get going on what we have known for decades that we must do. At two dollars per gallon for gasoline, there was not enough incentive, and it was understandable to lag the investment. However, four dollar a gallon gasoline has been a looming threat for a decade now, and an actual threat this year and parts of last year.

This study is one we can neither afford to pass on or to wait on. We must do it. We must do it now. Anyone who does not aggressively pursue this now will have hard questions to answer, and a tough uphill battle

in the face of those questions in the next election, if this opportunity is simply allowed to expire without any action.
