**RESOLUTION SUPPORTING EFFORTS TO HOUSE AT LEAST 130 HOMELESS VETERANS  
IN 2015 AND RECOGNIZING THOSE WHO HAVE HOUSED VETERANS IN SAN LUIS  
OBISPO COUNTY**

The following resolution is hereby offered and read:

WHEREAS, Veterans are national heroes and citizens of the County of San Luis Obispo appreciate their contributions to the security of the County and our nation; and

WHEREAS, the most recent homeless Point in Time Count for San Luis Obispo County found at least 130 homeless veterans in our County; and

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the County of San Luis Obispo has received 185 Housing Choice Vouchers for chronically homeless veterans under the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development-U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs' Supportive Housing program and those vouchers have already housed 105 homeless veterans in our County over the past three years; and

WHEREAS, several local nonprofit agencies last fall received three year grants under the federal Supportive Services for Veteran Families program for the purpose of providing rapid rehousing and employment services for homeless veterans and their families; and

WHEREAS, the County Office of Veteran Services and other County and local, nonprofit agencies are working together with SSVF recipient organizations towards the goal of housing at least 130 homeless veterans in 2015; and

WHEREAS, San Luis Obispo County is experiencing the lowest, multi-family rental vacancy rate in the State and the goal of housing 130 homeless veterans in 2015 will only be met with the assistance of private landlords willing to consider renting to homeless veterans participating in the aforementioned programs; and

WHEREAS, November 11, 2015 is Veterans Day.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, does hereby declare its support for efforts to house San Luis Obispo County's homeless veterans and recognizes and thanks those landlords, property managers, and property owners who have helped or will be helping to house homeless veterans in our County.
