RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF PROPOSED
AMENDMENTS TO THE 2010, 2011, 2013 AND 2014 ACTION PLANS OF THE URBAN
COUNTY OF SAN LUIS OBISPO CONSOLIDATED PLAN FOR THE COMMUNITY
DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM

The following resolution is hereby offered and read:

WHEREAS, the County of San Luis Obispo (hereinafter referred to as the “County”), a political subdivision of the State of California, sees a need to promote and protect decent and suitable housing and community development opportunities for the residents of this county; and

WHEREAS, the County encourages citizen participation in the amendment of the Consolidated Plan (hereinafter referred to as “the Plan”), which outlines the community needs for housing and community development; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (hereinafter referred to as “HUD”) confirmed designation of the County, including the cities of Arroyo Grande, Atascadero, Morro Bay, Paso Robles, Pismo Beach and San Luis Obispo, as an “Urban County” eligible to receive annual CDBG funding allocations directly through HUD to be used for the purposes set forth in the applicable federal statutes and regulations; and

WHEREAS, on May 4, 2010, the County of San Luis Obispo approved the 2010 Action Plan and received 2010 allocations of funds through the CDBG and HOME programs; and

WHEREAS, on May 10, 2011 the County approved the 2011 Action Plan and received 2011 allocations of funds through the CDBG and HOME programs; and

WHEREAS, on March 5, 2013, the County approved the 2013 Action Plan and received 2013 allocations of funds through the CDBG and HOME programs; and

WHEREAS, on February 25, 2014, the County approved the 2014 Action Plan and received 2014 allocations of funds through the CDBG program; and

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WHEREAS, a monitoring visit by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) in June 2014 determined that the City of Arroyo Grande used \$15,556 in 2010 CDBG funds on ineligible code enforcement activities; and

WHEREAS, the HUD monitoring visit determined the City of Arroyo Grande used \$7,887 in 2011 CDBG funds on ineligible façade improvement activities, and

WHEREAS, HUD required the combined repayment of \$23,443 in CDBG funds spent on ineligible code enforcement and façade improvement activities, and

WHEREAS, on October 14, 2014, the Arroyo Grande City Council approved the repayment of \$23,443 to HUD; and

WHEREAS, the Arroyo Grande City Council approved the elimination of all CDBG funded Façade Improvement Program activities, and

WHEREAS, the City of Arroyo Grande reallocated \$15,556 in 2010 CDBG funds from the “Code Enforcement Program” to the “Hoosegow Park ADA Project”, and

WHEREAS, the City of Arroyo Grande reallocated \$7,887 in 2011 CDBG funds from the “Façade Improvement Program” to the Hoosegow Park ADA Project”, and

WHEREAS, the City of Arroyo Grande reallocated \$10,000 in 2013 CDBG funds from the “Façade Improvement Program” to the “Hoosegow Park ADA Project”, and

WHEREAS, the City of Arroyo Grande reallocated \$5,000 in 2014 CDBG funds from the “Façade Improvement Program” to the “Hoosegow Park ADA Project”, and

WHEREAS, through these reallocations the Arroyo Grande City Council eliminated a total of \$38,443 in CDBG funded code enforcement and façade improvement projects; and

WHEREAS, On October 14, 2014 the Arroyo Grande City Council approved the reallocation of \$38,443 in 2010, 2011, 2013, and 2014 CDBG funds to the “Hoosegow Park ADA Project”; and

WHEREAS, HUD returned \$23,443 in repaid CDBG funds from the City of Arroyo Grande for ineligible costs to the County’s CDBG line of credit for use on CDBG eligible activities; and

WHEREAS, the Central Coast Senior Center declined a 2014 CDBG allocation in the amount of \$15,000 due to project costs increases and increased oversight; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Luis Obispo Department of Planning and Building request the amendment of the 2014 Action Plan to reallocate \$15,000 from the “Street and Parking Improvements Projects” by the Central Coast Senior Center to the “Los Osos Wastewater Connections Project” by the County of San Luis Obispo Department of Public Works; and

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WHEREAS, according to the Urban County's Community Participation Plan, said reallocation of funds and/or cancellation of approved projects triggers Section V(1) of the Consolidated Plan which requires a public hearing and approval by the County Board of Supervisors.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, as follows:

1. The County of San Luis Obispo approves the reallocation of CDBG funds in the 2010, 2011, 2013 and 2014 Action Plans by reallocating \$15,556 in 2010 CDBG funds from "Code Enforcement" to the "Hoosegow Park ADA Project"; reallocating \$7,887 in 2011 CDBG funds from the "Façade Improvement Program" to the "Hoosegow Park ADA Project"; reallocating \$10,000 in 2013 CDBG funds from the Façade Improvement Program" to the Hoosegow Park ADA Project"; reallocating \$5,000 in 2014 CDBG funds from the Façade Improvement Program" to the Hoosegow Park ADA Project"; and reallocating \$15,000 in 2014 CDBG funds from the "Street and Parking Improvements Project" to the Los Osos Wastewater Connections Project".
2. The County of San Luis Obispo approves and authorizes submittal to the federal Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) the amended 2010, 2011, 2013 and 2014 Action Plans to establish the activities for which the Urban County of San Luis Obispo will use Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program funds.
3. If the amendments to the 2010, 2011, 2013 and 2014 Action Plans are approved by HUD, the County of San Luis Obispo hereby agrees to use the CDBG funds for eligible activities in accordance with regulations cited above. It also may execute all other instruments necessary or required by HUD for participation in the CDBG Program.
4. On behalf of the County of San Luis Obispo, the Director of Planning and Building is hereby authorized and directed to transmit three certified copies of this resolution to HUD.
