SUBJECT: Submittal of a resolution accepting notice and approving an internet public auction, Sale Number 239, for tax-defaulted properties subject to the Tax Collector's Power to Sell. All Districts.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board adopt a Resolution Accepting Notice and Approving Sale of Tax-Defaulted Property Subject to the Tax Collector's Power to Sell. All Districts.

DISCUSSION

The California Revenue and Taxation Code (R&T Code), Division 1, Part 6, Chapter 7 requires the Tax Collector to offer for sale property that has become subject to sale by reason of nonpayment of taxes for more than five years. The sale must first be approved by the Board of Supervisors.

Prior to sale, extensive efforts are made to notify property owners and collect the defaulted taxes, as required by law. Notices of sale are sent by certified mail to the owners of record and any party of interest.

The Tax Collector proposes to sell tax-defaulted properties to the public at Internet Public Auction, Sale Number 239, beginning May 14, 2016, and ending May 17, 2016. There are currently one hundred fifteen (115) properties, located throughout the County, available for sale. None of the properties being offered are located within the California Valley area. The auction will be accessible to bidders through the Tax Collector's website (www.slocountytax.org). Individual properties can be redeemed until 5:00 p.m. on the last business day prior to the date of sale.

In the event that any parcel does not sell at the initial offering, the code allows for re-offering the property within 90 days of the original sale. The Tax Collector intends to re-offer any unsold parcels at Internet Public Auction, beginning June 11, 2016, and ending June 14, 2016. The auction will be accessible to bidders through the Tax Collector's website (www.slocountytax.org). The re-offered parcels may be offered at a reduced minimum bid.

The attached resolution will authorize Internet Public Auction Sale Number 239.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT

The Sale Resolution, property descriptions, proposed minimum bids, and the transmittal memorandum have been reviewed, and the resolution approved as to form and legal effect by County Counsel prior to submission to the Board of Supervisors. All substantiating documentation is maintained on file in the Tax Collector's Office.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

The California R&T Code requires that the minimum bid include the following:

- All defaulted taxes, assessments, associated penalties, and costs
- Redemption penalties and fees incurred through the month of the sale

- All other costs of the sale

Current year costs in the amount of \$22,851.00 will be reimbursed from the proceeds of the sale. Proceeds from the sale of the subject parcels will also be available to reimburse the loss of prior taxes to the extent possible based on the sale price.

In the event that any parcel does not sell at the initial offering, the code allows for reducing the minimum bid and re-offering the parcel for sale at a subsequent sale. In Sale Number 239, there are four (4) properties which were previously offered. These properties will be offered with an adjusted minimum bid of \$500.

RESULTS

The result of this Board action will authorize the sale of five year tax-defaulted property, which is required by statute.

Approval of this resolution will further the County's goals of a "Prosperous Community" by ensuring that the properties are re-entered on the tax roll as viable properties and that the delinquent taxes are paid.
