**COMMENDING OFFICER GARY FREDERIC BRITTON, #12487, 27 YEARS OF SERVICE TO THE CALIFORNIA HIGHWAY PATROL**

The following resolution is hereby offered and read:

**WHEREAS** Officer Gary Frederic Britton, #12487, joined the California Highway Patrol in 1988. After graduating from the CHP Academy in Sacramento, he reported to the Barstow Area office, where he worked for just over six years before transferring to the San Luis Obispo Area office; and

**WHEREAS**, Officer Britton served at the San Luis Obispo Area office for one year and was then assigned Coastal Division. While assigned to Coastal Division, Officer Britton was the Division training coordinator for two years, a Flight Officer for just over five years and then an investigator for two years; and

**WHEREAS**, Officer Britton then transferred back to the San Luis Obispo Area office for just under a year and then onto the Templeton Area office for nearly two years before transferring back to Coastal Division Air Operations for the remainder of his career; and

**WHEREAS**, during his career as a Highway Patrolman, Gary made many notable accomplishments. He was instrumental in creating an Employee Training Records System that is still in used today statewide. He was an instructor for new flight officers, set standards for statewide flight officer curriculum and training, and was a master of the communication system; and

**WHEREAS**, with over ten years of service on road patrol, more than thirteen years of service from the air, three years working administrative assignments and two years as an investigator, Gary proudly honored his commitment to the citizens of the great state of California for nearly 27 years.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, recognizes and thanks Officer Gary Frederic Britton for his service to the California Highway Patrol for 27 years and wishes him a long, happy and healthy retirement.
