SUBJECT: Letter transmitting plans and specifications (Clerk's File) for 2015-16 Chip Seal, Various County Roads, San Luis Obispo County, for project approval, advertisement of construction bids, and find that the project is exempt from Section 21000 et seq. of the California Public Resources code (CEQA). Bid opening date set for Monday, February 8, 2016. Districts 1, 4 and 5.

RECOMMENDATION

In accordance with applicable State Law, it is recommended that the Board:

1. Approve the project and adopt the plans and specifications for the construction of 2015-16 Chip Seal, Various Roads, San Luis Obispo County, Contract No. 300563; and
2. Authorize the contract to be advertised for construction bids, with a recommended bid opening date of Monday, February 8, 2016, and direct the Clerk of the Board to advertise a minimum of 21 calendar days before bid opening, no later than January 18, 2016; and
3. Provide the Public Works Director, or his designee, the discretion to extend the bid opening date to a date deemed more appropriate by the Director, or his designee, so long as any such extension is in compliance with all applicable laws; and
4. Find that the project is exempt from Section 21000 et seq. of the California Public Resources Code (CEQA).

DISCUSSION

This chip seal contract is part of the Department of Public Works Annual Maintenance Program which provides for the resurfacing of existing paved roads to extend the service life of the pavement. This work is necessary to halt further deterioration of these paved roads, and improve safety and operation. The project is a component of the pavement rehabilitation program that will be completed utilizing the \$11.2M (\$9.3M for pavement overlay and \$1.9M for pavement seal coats) from this fiscal year's program.

The contract provides for a chip seal on 30 miles of various County maintained roadways in the areas surrounding San Miguel, Atascadero, Pozo/Parkhill and Nipomo. The road segments selected for resurfacing are selected through the County's Pavement Management System and are identified in the 2015 Pavement Management Report.

Chip sealing is a process that includes the application of a polymer modified asphalt emulsion binder to which a layer of 5/16" aggregate is applied, providing a smooth wearing surface for vehicles and bicycles, while extending pavement life.

The project includes three additive bids. Based on the bids received and the balance of funds available in the program, the additive bids may be awarded.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT

Area utility companies were notified of our construction schedule and advised to proceed with any subsurface work prior to our chip seal project. Various utility valve lids, manholes and vaults will be protected during construction and will not be affected by the project.

County Counsel has approved the contract as to legal form and effect. The County Clerk formally processes the bid openings.

The County Environmental Coordinator has reviewed the project and determined that it is exempt from CEQA.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

This is a Pavement Management project budgeted in the Road Fund FY 2015-16 at \$1,902,182. The total project costs are estimated at \$828,009. Based on the balance of the Pavement Management funds, the additive bids may be awarded. Funding for the project will come from the Road Fund - Pavement Management Program.

At the time of project completion, when actual construction costs are known, any unused budget will be redirected to other planned Pavement Management projects. No budget adjustment is necessary.

RESULTS

Approval of the recommended action will result in this project being advertised for construction bids.
