SUBJECT: Letter transmitting plans and specifications (Clerk's File) for 2015-16 Surface Treatment, Various County Roads, San Luis Obispo County, for project approval, advertisement for construction bids, and find that the project is exempt from Section 21000 et seq. of the California Public Resources Code (CEQA). Bid opening date set for Monday, February 8, 2016. Districts 1, 4 and 5.

### **RECOMMENDATION**

In accordance with applicable State Law, it is recommended that the Board:

1. Approve the project and adopt the plans and specifications for the construction of 2015-16 Surface Treatment, Various County Roads, San Luis Obispo County, Contract No. 300544; and
2. Authorize the contract to be advertised for construction bids, with a recommended bid opening date of Monday, February 8, 2016, and direct the Clerk of the Board to advertise a minimum of 21 calendar days before bid opening, no later than January 18, 2016; and
3. Authorize the Public Works Director, or his designee, to extend the bid opening date to a date deemed more appropriate by the Director, or his designee, so long as any such extension is in compliance with all applicable laws.
4. Find that the project is exempt from Section 21000 et seq. of the California Public Resources Code (CEQA).

### **DISCUSSION**

This surface treatment contract is part of the Department of Public Works Annual Maintenance Program which provides for the resurfacing of existing paved roads to extend the service life of the pavement, halt further deterioration of these paved roads, and improve safety and operation. This is one of two seal coat projects that will be completed utilizing the \$11.2M (\$9.3M for pavement overlay and \$1.9M for pavement seal coats) from this fiscal year's pavement management program. This contract provides for a surface treatment on approximately 60 miles of various County maintained asphalt concrete roadways. The road segments selected for surface treatment are selected through the County's Pavement Management System and on-site inspection.

The County has several options to rehabilitate roads. Micro surfacing is a polymer-modified cold-mix paving system that is one of the most versatile tools used for road maintenance.

This project will be constructed using a combination of County forces and private contractors. County crews prepare the road surface by filling pot holes, sealing pavement cracks and removing any raised pavement markings. The contractor will apply the micro surfacing. This combination is part of the Pavement Management Plan maintenance strategy to increase the overall miles of roadway treated each year.

### **OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT**

Area utility companies were notified of our construction schedule and advised to proceed with any subsurface work prior to our surface treatment project. Various utility valve lids, manholes and vaults will be protected during construction and will not be affected by the project.

County Counsel has approved the contract as to legal form and effect. The County Clerk formally processes the bid openings.

The County Environmental Coordinator has reviewed the project and determined that it is exempt from CEQA.

### **FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS**

This is a Pavement Management project budgeted in the Road Fund FY 2015-16 at \$1,902,182. The total project costs are estimated at \$2,189,932. Funding for the project will come from the Road Fund - Pavement Management Program, Road Fund Reserves for Maria Vista Estates and North Mesa Assessment District.

At the time of award, when actual construction costs are known, we will return to the Board for a budget adjustment to appropriate necessary funding for the Maria Vista Estates and North Mesa Assessment District portions of the project. No budget adjustment is necessary at this time.

### **RESULTS**

Approval of the recommended action will result in this project being advertised for construction bids. Resurfacing the existing streets will provide for a safe and livable community.
