SUBJECT: Submittal of a resolution commending Eric N. Wier upon his retirement after 26 years with the County of San Luis Obispo. All Districts.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board adopt the attached resolution commending and thanking Eric N. Wier upon his retirement from the County of San Luis Obispo after 26 years of service to the County.

DISCUSSION

In July 1989, Eric began his public-sector career as an Environmental Specialist II in the Environmental Coordinator's Office in the Administration Department. In 1993, the Environmental Coordinator's Office was transferred from Administration to the Department of Planning and Building. In 2003, Eric was hired as one of the original members of the newly-formed Environmental Programs Division within the Department of Public Works.

As an Environmental Specialist and Environmental Resource Specialist with the County, Eric has always acted in the best interest of County residents conserving and enhancing environmental resources for the community's benefit while facilitating important development and public infrastructure projects.

Eric was an integral team member on many notable County public infrastructure projects including the Nacimiento Water Project, Los Osos Wastewater Project, Ferrasci Bridge Replacement, and Cambria Flood Control Project. During his Planning and Building days, his work included working with mine operators, other SLO County and Santa Barbara County staff, state agencies and consultants on the Rocky Canyon and Coast Rock Master Mining and Reclamation Plans, which helped avert a local shortage of permitted aggregate.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT

The Department of Public Works provides public services related to the safe and efficient movement of traffic on the 1,310 miles of County maintained roadways; engineering and surveying review of proposed land development; administration and operation of numerous water and wastewater wholesale and retail facilities, including the Lopez Water Supply, Nacimiento Water Supply, and Los Osos Wastewater projects; long term master water planning; and franchise administration; all for the

benefit of County residents either directly or through partnerships with the County's seven incorporated cities and numerous Community Services Districts. The Public Works Department's Vision is to be a valued community partner enhancing the quality of life for our fellow county residents. For over 26 years, Eric Wier has been a key part of that vision.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

There are no financial considerations associated with this action.

RESULTS

The result of your Board's action will provide a much deserved thanks and public acknowledgement of appreciation to Eric N. Wier for his dedicated 26 years of service to the residents of San Luis Obispo County.
