Re: Opposition to propose psychiatric health facility (Templeton)

Dear Supervisors:

I, the undersigned, am a concerned citizen who urges our leaders to vote against the proposed psychiatric facility in Templeton. My concerns are as follows:

- Imports thousands of patients from other counties; exceeds SLO County's needs.
- Facility is not a secure facility. At-risk patients may leave anytime, day or night.
- Burdens SLO County resources: water, public safety, schools, and traffic infrastructure.
- Houses school-age children; creates financial burden on SLO County School Districts.
- Community lacks support resources for large quantities of discharged patients.
- Facility is only for patients with private insurance; cannot accept Veterans or patients without insurance.
- Close proximity to residential neighborhoods full of young children.
- Project goes against recommendations of local TAAG advisory board.
- Project goes against concerns of many local Doctors; harms attraction of new Doctors.
- Project goes against concerns raised by Unified School District.
- Location and size driven by investor motives, not county's needs.
- Community believes it is wrong place and wrong size for our county.

This is NOT a project by locals and for locals. The out-of-town developer has stated on the record that he plans to sell the facility to a corporate Real Estate Investment Trust (REIT). If approved, project will draw thousands of patients per year from throughout the state.
