On Friday, March 11, 2016, the Planning Commission will reconvene and continue the hearing of the Phillips 66 Rail Spur project from their February 4th, 5th, and 25th 2016 meetings. Public testimony will continue and after all comments are received, public testimony will be closed. No action will be taken on the project until after the close of the public comment portion of the hearing.

Please bring your staff report dated February 4th to the hearing.

Members of the public who were unable to speak on February 25th and received a blue speaker slip are asked to arrive in the morning of March 11th and be prepared to speak when called. We will have new speaker slips for March 11, 2016. **All speaker slips must be submitted to the clerk by 10:00 AM, March 11, 2016. We will not be accepting any speaker slips for the hearing after 10:00 AM March 11, 2016.** In addition, we ask that each person speak only one time during the multiple day public hearing on this project. If someone has already spoken and turns in a speaker slip, we will return the speaker slip. Please note that anyone is welcome to submit comments in writing.

If a name and/or number is called and the speaker is not present, their time will be forfeited. We expect to close public comment on March 11, 2016.
