Regarding the Hearing (#8 - DRC2013-00020),

I am a resident of San Simeon, unable to attend the meeting personally. I appreciate the opportunity to send a brief comment via e-mail.

Most of the residents/homeowners in San Simeon do not want a Storage Facility in the community, with the resultant traffic, increased loitering and the very great likelihood of the units being converted into illegal dwellings.

We feel, quite strongly, that the community be allowed to remain as it is. As some of the Planning Commissioners will recall, we had the density of San Simeon increased substantially (despite a Growth Moratorium in place) by a very unpopular decision of the Board of Supervisors a few years ago. We do not want a similar bad decision made for our town, our community, our quality of life.

At some point, growth, consumption, and traffic have to be curtailed. If there is any doubt about that, one has only to read the latest death knell of the coral system - so vital to our ecosystem.
