SUBJECT: Submittal of a resolution authorizing submittal of grant applications to the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery to enhance the California Redemption Value (CRV) program. All Districts.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board adopt the resolution authorizing submittal of an application for payment programs and related authorizations to the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery.

DISCUSSION

In the late 1980's, the California Legislature enacted a program which placed a deposit on beverage containers. This program is commonly referred to as the California Redemption Value or CRV. The deposit is currently five (5) cents for small containers and ten (10) cents for large containers. The California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) is responsible for administering the statewide program.

Every year, CalRecycle provides funding to jurisdictions to enhance the CRV program. In San Luis Obispo County, the funding has ranged from \$5,000 to \$12,000 per year. For the last thirteen years, the San Luis Obispo County Integrated Waste Management Authority (IWMA) has worked with its member jurisdictions to apply for the funding. The IWMA has used the funding for various projects, such as technical assistance and purchasing recycling bins for businesses to start or enhance their recycling efforts. The IWMA has also been the entity to provide CalRecycle with the program and financial reporting required of the grant funding.

New this year, CalRecycle is requiring each jurisdiction to adopt a resolution which will be submitted with the grant application. The resolution is required in order to apply for CalRecycle funding, and authorizes the Public Works Director or designee to sign an application and related documents on behalf of the County.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT

The IWMA requested this resolution be adopted.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

None. Today's recommended action will allow for the IWMA to apply for grants.

RESULTS

Approval of the recommended action will help obtain grant funding related to recycling efforts, which will in turn contribute to a healthy and livable community.
