SUBJECT: Submittal of a resolution approving participation in the 2016-17 State-Local Partnership Program and designating the San Luis Obispo County Arts Council as the Local Arts Planning Agency for FY 2016-17. All Districts.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board adopt the resolution designating the San Luis Obispo County Arts Council's as the Local Arts Planning Agency for the State-Local Partnership Program for FY 2016-17.

DISCUSSION

In 1981, the San Luis Obispo County Arts Council was formed to serve as the local partner for San Luis Obispo County. By agreeing to serve as the central arts organization for the county, the Arts Council receives grant funding on an annual basis from the California Arts Council.

The grant application submitted to the State must be accompanied by a resolution from the Board of Supervisors that gives approval to the State-Local partnership relationship and to the designation of the San Luis Obispo County Arts Council as the local partner. Without the local government resolution the Arts Council is ineligible for the grant funding. This is not a funding obligation for the County, but an endorsement of the Arts Council's designation as the central art organization for the County.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT

The State-Local Partnership Program Grant Review and Advisory Panel will review applications for the 2016-17 fiscal year and determine the level of funding that the San Luis Obispo County Arts Council will receive.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

The California Arts Council's State-Local Partnership Program requires matching funds, at a level of 1:1, which may be from any public or private source and in some instances, in-kind donated services can be used towards the require match. The FY 2016-17 maximum grant from the State Arts Council for the State-Local Partnership Program is \$30,000. The Board of Supervisors approved funding from the General Fund for the Arts Council in the amount of \$21,000 during FY 2015-16 budget hearings.

RESULTS

This action will confirm the San Luis Obispo County Arts Council as the County's local partner, thereby, allowing a grant application to be submitted to the California Arts Council. The State-Local Partnership Program Grant Review and Advisory Panel will review applications for FY 2016-17 and determine the level of funding that the San Luis Obispo County Arts Council will receive.
