SUBJECT: Request to approve a renewal agreement (Clerk's File) for one year (April 1, 2016- May 31, 2017) with the California Family Health Council, Inc. (CFHC) in the amount of \$129,700 to conduct reproductive health outreach and education activities. All Districts.

## **RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the Board:

- 1) Approve the one year renewal agreement (April 1, 2016-May 31, 2017) with CFHC in the amount of \$129,700 to conduct reproductive health outreach and education activities; and
- 2) Authorize the Health Officer to sign any amendments to the agreement for Title X family planning services that do not increase the level of General Fund Support.

## **DISCUSSION**

The Title X Family Planning program is a federal program begun in 1970 upon enactment of Title X of the Public Health Service Act. Title X grant funding is dedicated to providing individuals with comprehensive family planning and related preventive health services. The Title X program gives priority to individuals from low-income families and is designed to provide access to voluntary contraceptive services, supplies and information.

The Public Health Department has provided family planning services for decades, and has done so through a combination of County General Fund support, fees, and State funding. The funds will be used to augment outreach and reproductive health education for low income and underserved populations. Target groups include individuals with limited English proficiency, migrant workers, males, adolescents, incarcerated individuals, and Women, Infants and Children (WIC) clients and low-income breastfeeding women, particularly those seen at the Paso Robles Public Health clinic.

## **OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT**

County Counsel has approved the renewal agreement as to form and legal effect.

## **FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS**

The Title X Family Planning agreement provides funding in the amount of \$129,700 for April 1, 2016 through May 31, 2017. The current agreement remains at \$129,700, the same funding amount as calendar year 2015. These funds are used to augment existing family planning services through outreach and education. Family Health Services staff attends WIC clinics, parenting classes, and other community events to educate and refer potential clients to reproductive health services. The Public Health Departments FY 2015-16 budget and FY 2016-17 includes \$32,425 and \$97,275, respectively, in expense and revenue for the Title X Family Planning agreement. Approval of the renewal agreement will

not increase the level of General Fund Support required for the Health Agency.

**RESULTS**

Approval of the recommended action will allow the Public Health Family Planning program staff to offer reproductive health outreach and education to underserved population groups. More specific goals of the initiative include:

- Clients will be informed about contraceptive methods in order to plan for parenting/childbearing.
- Clients will receive current information/education on pre-conception care, in order to have children born healthy.
- Clients will be assisted in establishing reproductive health plans and in gaining access to reproductive health clinical services.

Target numbers by high-risk, hard-to-reach populations are as follows:

Persons with Limited English Proficiency	500
Migrant Workers	150
Males	350
Adolescents	250

The overall result of this enhancement to the Family Planning program will contribute to the County-wide goal of a Healthy Community.
