SUBJECT: Hearing to consider a resolution to adopt the 2015 Urban Water Management Plan Update for the Lopez Reservoir, Zone 3 of the San Luis Obispo County Flood Control and Water Conservation District. Districts 3 and 4.

## **RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the Board, acting as the Board of Supervisors for the San Luis Obispo Flood Control and Water Conservation District:

1. Hold a public hearing to review and discuss the 2015 Urban Water Management Plan Update for Zone 3; and
2. Approve the attached resolution adopting the 2015 Urban Water Management Plan Update for Zone 3.

## **DISCUSSION**

State mandate (Water Code Section 10610 et seq.) requires every urban water supplier that provides water to 3,000 or more customers or over 3,000 acre-feet of water per year to complete an Urban Water Management Plan (UWMP) every five (5) years. This UWMP act applies to Zone 3 and also separately applies to other purveyors within Zone 3 such as the Cities of Arroyo Grande, Grover Beach, and Pismo Beach. The last UWMP plan for Zone 3 was prepared and adopted in 2011.

At a minimum, the UWMP must generally include the following:

- A thorough description of the water sources and water supply system
- Current water demand and projections for 20 years or more
- Analysis on the reliability of the water source
- Description of the water shortage and drought contingency plans
- Description of Demand Management Measures (i.e. water conservation programs)
- Explanation on Demand Management Measures not implemented
- Discussion on programs for water recycling
- Discussion on programs for desalinization

Added this round, the 2015 UWMP Update must include a discussion on the urban water supplier's progress in achieving 20x2020 targets (20% reduction in per capita urban water consumption by 2020) and implementation goals. The final UWMP must be adopted by your Board no later than July 1, 2016, and it must be submitted to the Department of Water Resources no later than August 1, 2016.

### **OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT**

The Department of Water Resources will receive the UWMP and check it for completeness. The UWMP was made available for review by each of the land use planning agencies within Zone 3 including the Cities of Pismo Beach, Arroyo Grande, and Grover Beach.

The District, or their consultant, has directly coordinated with retail purveyors within Zone 3 including the City of Pismo Beach, the City of Grover Beach, the City of Arroyo Grande, the South San Luis Obispo County Sanitation District, the Avila Beach Community Services District, Port San Luis, the Oceano Community Services District, and Avila Valley Mutual Water Company.

This item was discussed at the Zone 3 Advisory Committee meeting on May 19, 2016, and with the Zone 3 Technical Advisory Committee on April 7 and May 5, 2016. The Technical Advisory Committee supported bringing the UWMP to your Board for adoption.

### **FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS**

While the UWMP identifies several programs that are budgeted and funded separately, no additional funding will be required for the adoption of the UWMP.

Per the Integrated Regional Water Management Plan (IRWM) grant application guidelines, a water supplier must submit a complete UWMP to the California Department of Water Resources DWR in order to be considered for Integrated Regional Water Management (IRWM) and Stormwater Flood Management (SWFM) funding. Further, applicants and project proponents that have projects that would receive funding through the IRWM grant program must have a 2015 UWMP that has been verified as complete by DWR before a grant agreement can be executed.

### **RESULTS**

Approval of the recommended action will ensure that Zone 3 will maintain compliance with State law and that the Flood Control and Water Conservation District will remain eligible for State funds, resulting in a more livable and well governed community.
