## **RECOMMENDATION**

## **DISCUSSION**

The following list of vehicles have been approved for replacement in the FY16/17 budget and need to be declared surplus to allow them to be disposed of at public auction.

## **OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT**

Central Services coordinates the disposition of the equipment via a public auction.

Diesel equipment, such as the dump trucks and sweeper truck, are being phased out under California Air Resources Board (CARB) requirements for air emissions reductions. Public agencies are subject to the CARB criteria for retrofit or replacement.

## **FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS**

These vehicles will be sold at public auction after being replaced. Proceeds from the sales will be deposited into the Public Works Internal Service Fund (ISF) Equipment Replacement Reserves.

## **RESULTS**

Disposition of the surplus equipment generates revenue for the ISF equipment replacement reserves, and enables Public Works to effectively manage the Department's fleet of vehicles and equipment.
