SUBJECT: Request to approve an agreement with the Nipomo Chamber of Commerce allocating \$4,000 from District Four Community Project Funds – Fund Center 106 to be used for expenses associated with holding the summer concert series July 17th and August 21st, 2016 and the annual October Festival on October 15th and 16th, 2016. RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of Supervisors approve the agreement with Nipomo Chamber of Commerce allocating \$4,000 from District Four Community Project Funds – Fund Center 106 to be used for expenses associated with holding the summer concert series July 17th and August 21st, 2016 and the annual October Festival on October 15th and 16th, 2016.

DISCUSSION

The mission of the Nipomo Chamber of Commerce is to promote the civic, economic, agricultural, educational and social welfare of Nipomo. In pursuit of those goals, the organization sponsors many community events throughout the year. One such event is the October Festival being held on October 15th and 16th, 2016 at Nipomo Community Park. The Festival provides networking opportunities for not only the business and service organizations but also brings together these organizations for the local residents to have access to. In addition, the Chamber will be sponsoring the first annual series of summer concerts. The concerts will be held on July 17th and August 21st, 2016. Both events are free to the public.

The total amount of \$4,000 in County funds will be used towards expenses associated with holding the October Festival on October 15th and 16th, 2016 and the two summer concerts on July 17th and August 21st, 2016. The events will be held at Nipomo Park and expenses include but are not limited to park rental fees, generator, portable toilets, trash containers/collections, and advertising.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

Funding in the amount of \$4,000 will be allocated from District Four Community Project Funds – Fund Center #106 to the Nipomo Chamber of Commerce.

The funds will be used towards expenses associated with holding both events. The October Festival provides networking opportunities for not only the business and service organizations but also serves as informational source for local resident to know the types of services available to them.
