In response to the April 8, 2016 Notice – Reallocation of City of Atascadero CDBG funds, the City of Morro Bay would hereby like to apply for a commitment of the Atascadero funds.

The City of Morro Bay has reviewed the conditions associated with the RFP notice and would be able meet the required drawdown deadline of September 30, 2016.

The proposed City of Morro Bay project would be the City's Pedestrian Accessibility Project. As you know, previous Morro Bay CDBG funding has been awarded to improving Pedestrian Accessibility in the greater downtown area., where the City has a large number of streets that are not ADA accessible and/or in need of pedestrian accessibility improvements. The request for a commitment of the reallocated Atascadero funds would allow the City to provide more pedestrian accessibility and is within the same project area as evaluated in the NEPA review completed in 2013. This request has already been pre-approved by the City of Morro Bay City Council via a public hearing held on December 8, 2015 date and as evidenced by Council Resolution 75-15.
