Dear Supervisors,

Almost a year ago we started the effort to create a Vacation Rental Ordinance for SLO county. After much discussion, the need to carve out the Adelaida area became apparent for several reasons. It is an unincorporated agricultural area with hilly terrain and narrow windy roads making response time to accidents, fires, etc., extremely long. In recent years there has been an ever-increasing number of wineries, olive oil farms, and supporting industries coming into the area. This growth in such an area has not been experienced in all of the SLO county districts, and so the carve out is the logical solution.

You and staff have guided us and encouraged us to stay involved and work toward a specific VR ordinance for the Adelaida. The draft is ready for public input. Next Tuesday, I urge you to keep the ball rolling toward a much needed solution to a growing problem.
