RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of Supervisors approve the agreement with the Arroyo Grande and Grover Beach Chamber of Commerce allocating \$3,000 from District Three Community Project Funds – Fund Center #106 to be used for expenses associated with holding the 26th annual Stone Soup Music Faire on August 27th and 28th, 2016.

DISCUSSION

The mission of the Arroyo Grande and Grover Beach Chamber of Commerce is to enhance the well-being of the residents and visitors by developing and promoting the local Grover Beach and Arroyo Grande businesses. One of the ways this is done is by sponsoring events such as the annual Stone Soup Music Faire. The Festival, in its 26th year, will be held on August 27th and 28th, 2016 at Ramona Park in Grover Beach. The event includes over 16 musical acts over two stages. There will be international foods and over 90 unique vendor booths, a dune walk (5k/10k walk/run). There will be a number of activities for kids such as bounce houses and a miniature train. The event is free to the public.

The \$3,000 in County funds will be used towards expenses associated with holding the Stone Soup Music Faire August 27th and 28th, 2016 including but not limited to advertising, children's activities, and marketing.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

Funding in the amount of \$3,000 will be allocated from Community Project Funds – Fund Center #106 to the Arroyo Grande and Grover Beach Chamber of Commerce

RESULTS

The funds will be used towards expenses associated with holding the annual event. The Faire is a family-friendly event that appeals to a cross section of the community and the dune walk/run promotes healthy living. The inclusion of various service organizations provides networking opportunities and information for local residents. The event is free to the public.
