I have been alerted that item #3 on next Tuesday's consent agenda involves moving the evacuation center from Santa Maria High School to the New Tech High School in Nipomo in case of a release of radiation at Diablo Canyon.

Should prevailing winds be blowing in their usual pattern, there is a strong likelihood that New Tech High School would be in the direct plume of radiation. Santa Maria is too close; Nipomo is unacceptably close.
