
Figure 3-4 (a PG&E windrose map) is included below in this letter. It clearly shows that the strongest and longest prevailing winds blow South West of the plant, toward Nipomo.

Please remove Item 3 from the Consent Items Agenda of the August 9 Board of Supervisor's meeting. We request that it be rescheduled as an item for public discussion at a future meeting.

We also request that each Supervisor take a look at PG&E's map showing wind direction and speed on page 110 of the County Nuclear Power Plant Emergency Response Plan at <http://www.slocounty.ca.gov/Assets/OES/Plans/NPP+Admin+Plan.pdf>

You will note that the most frequent direction of the wind from Diablo is SE - toward Nipomo. If you add up the percentage of times the wind blows SE, SSE and ESE you get 52% of the time. This would indicate that Nipomo is not a sensible location for an evacuation and decontamination center for children in the event of an accident or other event leading to release of radiation from the Diablo Canyon plant. The general public, which of course includes the parents of school children and the teachers who will be first responders in the event of such an accident, should have the opportunity to become fully informed of the implications of such a proposal and to voice their opinions at a future Board of Supervisors' meeting.

Thank you for reconsidering the placement of Item 3 on the Consent Agenda.
