SUBJECT: Submittal of a resolution accepting an Avigation Easement from Phillip Kissel and Janice Kissel, Trustees of the Kissel Family Trust dated June 6, 2003, for the San Luis Obispo County Regional Airport. District 3.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board adopt and instruct the Chairperson to sign the resolution accepting the avigation easement for the San Luis Obispo County Regional Airport and instruct the County Clerk-Recorder to record said easement.

DISCUSSION

Attached is an avigation easement document from Phillip Kissel and Janice Kissel, Trustees of the Kissel Family Trust dated June 6, 2003, which grants an avigation easement to the County of San Luis Obispo over property near the San Luis Obispo County Regional Airport, together with a Resolution accepting said easement and directing the county Clerk-Recorder to record same. The avigation easement was required because the project site is within the Airport Review combining designation area. The project is a Vesting Tentative Parcel Map (CO13-101) to subdivide an existing 7.4 acre parcel into two parcels of 2.0 and 5.4 each for the purpose of sale and/or development. The project is located at 1610 Calle Crotalo, east of Orcutt Road, adjacent to the southeastern limit of the City of San Luis Obispo. The site is in the north San Luis Obispo subarea of the San Luis Obispo planning area. The project was approved by the Subdivision Review Board on September 14, 2015.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT

County Counsel reviewed and approved the easement and resolution as to form and legal effect.

Approval of this item will create an easement over the airspace above the said parcel. This airspace provides aircraft with unobstructed access to the airport runway consistent with the Countywide goal of a Safe Community.
