SUBJECT: Submittal of a resolution for the acceptance of Leonard Place, a segment of Richard Avenue, and a segment of Ellis Avenue into the County maintained road system, in the community of Cambria. District 2.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board adopt the attached resolution accepting Leonard Place, a segment of Richard Avenue, and a segment of Ellis Avenue into the County maintained road system, in the community of Cambria.

DISCUSSION

County Service Area No. 21 was formed by resolution of the Board of Supervisors on September 20, 1984, in order to provide cooperative road improvement services to the residents and property owners in San Luis Obispo County. The Cooperative Road Program provides funding from a General Fund appropriation so that non-standard roads can be improved to meet current County road standards and, if necessary, be accepted into the County road maintenance system.

Under this Cooperative Road Program, on January 27, 2015, the Board of Supervisors authorized the formation of the *Road Improvement Zone – Leonard Place of County Service Area No. 21*, and called a special tax election. Following a successful election on May 5, 2015, of Measure A-15 by the adjacent property owners, road improvements along Leonard Place and segments of Richard Avenue and Ellis Avenue were constructed as shown on Attachment 2. Each year, the properties within this road improvement zone will be assessed until the full cost of construction has been reimbursed back to the General Fund.

The Board policy for the Cooperative Road Program is to accept completed roads into the road maintenance system. In accordance with policy, the recommended action is for your Board to approve the attached resolution to accept existing offers of dedication to the public for road purposes, and to accept 0.03 miles of Leonard Place, 0.02 miles of Richard Avenue, and 0.01 miles of Ellis Avenue into the County's maintained road system.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT

County Counsel has reviewed and approved the attached resolution as to legal form and effect.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

This action will increase the total mileage of County maintained roads by 0.06 miles. Based on the current average cost per mile, this will increase annual road maintenance costs by \$1,383. To date, this fiscal year's cumulative road maintenance increase resulting from accepting additional roads is \$1,383.

RESULTS

The result of this action will be to accept the roads into the County maintained road system. This will ensure that this transportation link will be able to serve the public needs in the future.
