RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING SEPTEMBER 27, 2016 “NATIONAL VOTER
REGISTRATION DAY” IN SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY**

The following resolution is hereby offered and read:

WHEREAS, the County Clerk-Recorder, along with the California Secretary of State, is committed to empowering all Californians to be informed, active members of our democracy; and

WHEREAS, consistent civic engagement contributes to a more representative government; and

WHEREAS, nearly seven million eligible Californians are not currently registered to vote in the upcoming November 8, 2016, Presidential General Election; and

WHEREAS, increasing voter registration is essential to reaching the goal of having eligible California citizens participate in our democracy by casting a ballot on Election Day; and

WHEREAS, technology, including California’s online voter registration application, is helping to remove barriers to voting, giving citizens greater access to voting resources; and

WHEREAS, every Californian can encourage their families, friends, co-workers, and neighbors to register to register and exercise their right to vote; and

WHEREAS, California businesses, community groups, nonprofit organizations, and public agencies can help mobilize their communities to vote in all elections; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, does hereby proclaim September 27, 2016, as “National Voter Registration Day” and encourages all eligible Californians to register to vote.
