SUBJECT: Submittal of a resolution establishing changes to the Traffic Regulation Codes for no parking zones on Ontario Road, Avila Beach; Wilmar Avenue and Nineteenth Street, Oceano; Thompson Avenue, Nipomo; disabled parking zone on Mission Street, San Miguel; and designated fire lanes throughout San Luis Obispo County. All Districts.

### **RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the Board adopt the attached resolution establishing changes to the County's Traffic Regulation Code sections involving no parking zones, disabled parking zone and establishment of fire lanes by local authorities.

### **DISCUSSION**

The Department of Public Works received requests for parking restrictions or have identified the following locations:

#### *No Parking Zone*

**Ontario Road, Avila Beach** – Ontario Road is a two lane rural road providing access to the recreational land use. The Avila Trolley has a designated stop just south of the Bob Jones Park and Ride lot entrance. Currently, vehicles have parked at the bus stop during peak weekend use. The attached resolution will establish a no parking zone on the easterly side of Ontario Road at the entrance of the Bob Jones Park and Ride lot for the trolley stop. The action was initiated by Public Works following a field review of the area. The Avila Valley Advisory Committee has been notified.

**Wilmar Avenue, Oceano** – Wilmar Avenue is a two lane road providing access to residential land use. There is a permitted bus stops for South County Transit which requires a no parking zone. The attached resolution will establish a no parking zone on the northerly side of Wilmar Street just east of Thirteenth Street and on the southerly side of Wilmar Avenue just west of Nineteenth Street. The action was initiated by Public Works following the issuance of an encroachment permit to the

San Luis Obispo Regional Transit Authority for the bus stop. The Oceano Advisory Committee has been notified.

**Nineteenth Street, Oceano** – Nineteenth Street is a two lane road providing access to residential and business land use. Currently, there is a permitted bus stop for South County Transit which requires a no parking zone. The attached resolution will establish a no parking zone on the easterly side of Nineteenth Street adjacent to the Oceano Community Services District (CSD). The action was initiated by Public Works following the issuance of an encroachment permit to San Luis Obispo Regional Transit Authority for the bus stop. The Oceano Advisory Committee has been notified.

**Thompson Avenue, Nipomo** – Thompson Avenue is a two lane collector providing access to Highway 101 as well as residential and business land uses. Currently, there is an existing bus stop for Regional Transit Authority Route 10 which requires a no parking zone. In addition, north of the bus stop, trucks are currently parking overnight. The attached resolution will modify an existing no parking zone just north of Branch Street for the bus stop as well as establish a limited parking zone from 2:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. from the bus stop to Chestnut Street. The action was initiated by Public Works following a request from a Nipomo resident and subsequent site visit by Public Works. The South County Advisory Committee has been notified.

#### *Disabled Parking Zone*

**Mission Street, San Miguel** – Mission Street is a two lane arterial providing access to businesses. There is angled parking on the west side of the road which includes disabled parking. Currently, there are three disabled parking locations on the west side of Mission Street. Disabled parking is a requirement based on the number of marked parking stalls. The attached resolution will formally establish disabled parking on Mission Street south of Fourteenth Street, Thirteenth Street and Twelfth Street. The San Miguel Advisory Council has been notified.

#### *Designated Fire Lanes*

Per California Vehicle Code (CVC) Section 22500.1, the fire district or fire department may designate fire lanes within their jurisdiction on any publicly or privately owned highway or parking facility. Enforcement as a Tow-Away zone is allowed under the CVC. These fire lanes are not required to be individually adopted by local resolution. To assist the California Highway Patrol and Sheriff's Department in enforcing these areas, the attached resolution will provide a code for ticketing. Marking of the Fire Lanes will be up to the individual fire districts.

The action originated out of a request from the San Miguel Community Service District seeking Fire Lane designations on the existing alleyways in town.

Staff recommends your Board adopt the attached resolution to establish no parking and disabled parking at these locations.

Adoption of these regulations does not require a public hearing.

## **OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT**

The California Highway Patrol and the Sheriff's Department will enforce these restrictions, once posted. The advisory committees and CALFire have been notified.

## **FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS**

Placement of additional signs is estimated to cost \$500 or less per location. This is within the Road Fund's budgeted amount for this activity.

## **RESULTS**

Adoption of this Resolution will enhance County road safety and operations by establishing no parking and disabled parking zones, thus improving community livability.
