SUBJECT: Request to amend the Fixed Asset List for Fund Center 138 – Emergency Services to include the addition of an equipment trailer and removal of Evacuee Monitoring and Decontamination (EMAD) related tents.

RECOMMENDATION

The County Office of Emergency Services recommends that your Board authorize amending the Fixed Asset List for Fund Center 138 - Emergency Services to include the addition of an equipment trailer and removal of EMAD related tents.

DISCUSSION

The relocation of the Evacuee Monitoring and Decontamination (EMAD) Center from Santa Maria to Nipomo requires the purchase of a replacement trailer to store the supplies and equipment. The trailer previously used for that purpose at the former EMAD Center location was owned by the City of Santa Maria.

The Board approved the Southern EMAD move and the MOU between San Luis Obispo County and the Lucia Mar Unified School District on August 9, 2016, Agenda Item 3. The Southern EMAD Center was moved from the Santa Maria Fairpark to Nipomo High School/Central Coast New Tech High School.

The purpose of the EMAD Centers is that in the event a nuclear power plant emergency required evacuations within the Diablo Canyon Emergency Planning Zone, locations to the north and south would be opened to provide reception, radiation monitoring and, if necessary, decontamination to the general public.

The equipment trailer will be purchased using already budgeted funds from State Aid Nuclear Planning for capital outlay equipment that had been originally budgeted for EMAD related tents. The request to purchase EMAD related tents will be deferred until next fiscal year as they are not an immediate need, whereas the equipment trailer is an immediate need.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT

Fleet Services has obtained bids and will be purchasing the trailer using the standard purchasing process.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

The \$13,000 is already included in the adopted FY 2016-17 County budget for OES for capital outlay equipment and is available from already budgeted nuclear power plant emergency planning funds. No additional General Fund support monies are being requested with this Board agenda item.

RESULTS

Use of these funds enhances the County's continued ability to develop and maintain effective emergency plans and procedures, and results in a coordinated response to disasters by public and related agencies. This coordinated response ensures that OES meets the communitywide goal of a safe community.
