SUBJECT: Request to approve an agreement with Oceano Depot Association allocating \$2,000 from District Four Community Project Funds - Fund Center #106 to be used for upgrading and repairing the historical Oceano Depot. District 4.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board approved the agreement with Oceano Depot Association allocating \$2,000 from District Four Community Project Funds - Fund Center #106.

DISCUSSION

The Oceano Depot Association's purpose is to restore, preserve and operate the historic Oceano Depot along with other structures that have a historical, scientific, educational and recreational significance in the community of Oceano. The Depot is visited regularly by visitors and residents, and provides educational programs for school age children. The history of the railroad in the county is preserved at the Depot. The Association's current project is the repair and restoration of the floors and deck at the Depot. These updates are essential for protecting the historical value of the Depot but more importantly ensure the safety of the many visitors and children that visit the Oceano Depot.

The \$2,000 in County funds will be used towards expenses associated with repairing and restoring the decking at the Oceano Depot.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT

The Oceano Depot Association will oversee the upgrade and repair to the historical Oceano Depot.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

Funding in the amount of \$2,000 will be allocated from District Four Community Project Funds – Fund Center #106 to the Oceano Depot Association.

RESULTS

The Oceano Depot's floors and deck will be repaired and restored helping to protect the historical value of the Depot. In addition, the upgrades will ensure the safety of the many visitors and children that visit the Oceano Depot.
