SUBJECT: Submittal of a Resolution honoring the California County Planning Directors Association on the Occasion of its 50th Anniversary

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that your Board adopt the attached Resolution honoring the California County Planning Directors Association on the occasion of its 50th Anniversary.

DISCUSSION

In 1961, an informal group of Planning Directors from across the state of California recognized the need and benefit of shared information and professional development, and came together to formally establish the California County Planning Directors Association (CCPDA).

In association with the California State Association of Counties (CSAC), the CCPDA has actively participated in the legislative process in an effort to encourage the development and passage of legislation which supports sound planning principles and practices, the efficient implementation of state regulations, and fosters greater local control over land use decisions. The CCPDA network has grown in reputation and experience through the years and is often a venue where emerging planning approaches and practices are first addressed.

Currently, CCPDA is leading a statewide effort, with a working group with over 70 individuals, to write a California Model Solar Energy Facility Ordinance and Guidance Document to create a consistent strategy for counties to permit small to large scale photovoltaic installations. The Model Ordinance and Guidance Document are scheduled for adoption by CCPDA at the Winter Conference on February 3, 2012 in Sacramento, California.

Over the years, San Luis Obispo County management has actively participated in the CCPDA's activities and has gained invaluable assistance and professional development thereby strengthening our county's planning projects and programs. Past County Planning Directors, Ned Rogoway, Paul Crawford, Alex Hinds and Victor Holanda were all involved with the organization and brought the benefits of the CCPDA directly to our County. This tradition has continued to today with both the Planning Director, Jason Giffen and Assistant Planning Director, Kami Griffin being active members in the CCPDA.

At this year's Winter Conference, CCPDA will be celebrating its 50th Anniversary and on this occasion the County of San Luis Obispo wishes it many more years as a leading organization in the advancement of high quality, comprehensive planning through professional and educational activities related to county government.
