Re: Access to Willow Road

Gentlemen:

I have been going to meetings regarding this project for the past 20 years. Every time I asked the same questions regarding access, light, air quality, and noise mitigation measures. Every time I was told that if I had access to the road now, that I will have access to the road when it's constructed, that air, noise, and light is not going to be mitigated for the houses that are not in the decibel range of the road. I am already impacted by the headlights that are directed at my house by cars at the intersection of Willow and Hetrick. I only see the project bringing more objectionable transient light directed to my house as the roads use intensifies. I now am impacted by the noise of construction, and have had to insist that the backup alarms be silenced at 10PM, an hour after the conditions of approval for the project indicate work is to cease. And now the final issue to be resolved is the access. At all the meetings I have attended and have gotten the same response regarding access, if I have it now, it will be maintained. I am now being told that I will get no access to the road even though I have had access to the road for the past 20+ years. I have routed the delivery of my mobile home, the delivery of my storage building, and have had cattle from Andy and Susie Hermricks herd on my place. It is unacceptable to negatively impact my residence with diminished air quality, objectionable transient light, and noise from a heavily traveled road (which I had to pay increased improvement fees for), and be denied access to that road. All this time I have been told by the construction personnel, you will be provided access like the properties along Willow, between Hetrick and Pomeroy. Those properties have access, even though some have access on Live Oak Ridge Rd., they have access to Willow.

Please understand that through all the processes that I have been involved with in conjunction with the Willow Road Project, I have been told the same thing by County Staff, "you will have access if you currently have access", I am appalled that this is an issue at this point, the road negatively impacts my residence and I can't get access, that is wrong. We need to get this worked out, soon.
