SUBJECT: Submittal of a resolution amending the Traffic Regulation Code to establish no parking zones on Main Street, Cambria; Florence Street, Templeton; Buckley Road, San Luis Obispo Fringe; and limited parking zones on Tefft Street, Nipomo; South Ocean Avenue, Cayucos; Cayucos Drive, Cayucos; Encina Avenue, Santa Margarita.

RECOMMENDATION

It is our recommendation that your Honorable Board adopt the attached resolution amending the County's Traffic Regulation Code sections involving limited and no parking zones.

DISCUSSION

The Department of Public Works has received requests from the public to evaluate parking at the following locations:

Main Street, Cambria

Public Works received a call regarding a curb being painted red illegally in front of a residential complex at 2650 Main Street. Staff verified that the curb was painted red and contacted the property owner to have the red paint removed. At that time, a request was made to install a no parking zone west of the driveway since parked vehicles blocked the sight distance of traffic exiting the complex. Staff has investigated the site and recommends that a 30 foot no parking zone be established to improve the sight distance.

Florence Street, Templeton

Public Works received a request to limit parking along the west side of Florence Street just north of Salinas Street to increase sight distance at the intersection. In reviewing this concern, Staff determined that the removal of about 60 feet of parking would provide adequate sight distance at this intersection. It also appears that the vehicles parking at this location are either blocking the bike lane, the sidewalk, or are in a bio-swale maintained by the County. Staff recommends the establishment of a 60 foot no parking zone at this location.

Buckley Road, San Luis Obispo Fringe

Public Works received a call regarding parked vehicles blocking the sight distance at a commercial driveway on the south side of Buckley Road at the easternmost Strasbaugh Driveway. Staff reviewed the location and recommends that a 100 foot no parking zone be established to provide adequate sight distance.

Tefft Street, Nipomo

Public Works received a call requesting that a 10 minute parking zone be placed on the south side of Tefft Street between US 101 and Oakglen Avenue. Staff reviewed the location and noticed that vehicles were being parked at this location for several hours. This long term parking is causing delivery trucks to double park on Tefft Street while delivering to the adjacent businesses. Staff recommends establishing a forty foot long 10 minute parking zone on Tefft Street at this location. The fronting business owners and residents support this action.

South Ocean Avenue and Cayucos Drive, Cayucos

Public Works received a request from the Cayucos Citizens Advisory Council and Cayucos Chamber of Commerce to install several 30 minute parking places along South Ocean Avenue and Cayucos Drive. Staff discussed these options with the business owners that would be the most affected and is recommending that three 30 minute parking places be installed at the following locations:

- In front of 130 South Ocean Avenue next to an existing disable parking space.
- In front of 175 Ocean Avenue.
- In front of 55 Cayucos Drive.

Encina Avenue, Santa Margarita

Recently, a business property at the northwest corner of El Camino Real and Encina Avenue was redeveloped. As part of the redevelopment, Encina Avenue was improved to include a sidewalk and angled parking. Historically, this location has also served as an informal park-and-ride lot. The business owner has requested a 2 hour parking zone to provide parking turnover. This would allow for this parking to be primarily used by customers of various businesses in downtown Santa Margarita. Staff recommends establishing a 2 hour parking zone on the west side of Encina Avenue between El Camino Real and the Alleyway.

Adoption of these regulations does not require a public hearing.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT

The California Highway Patrol and the Sheriff's Department will enforce these restrictions, once posted. The affected Community Advisory Councils have reviewed and supported each of the proposed changes in their areas.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

Placement of signs is estimated to cost approximately \$5,000. This is within the Road Fund's budgeted amount for this activity.

RESULTS

Adoption of this Resolution will enhance County road safety and operations by assuring traffic flow, improved site distance and improved pedestrian access, thus improving community livability.
