SUBJECT: Request to approve a three-year renewal agreement (Clerk's File) with the California Department of Public Health to implement the Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention Program.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board approve: (1) the three-year renewal agreement with the California Department of Public Health to implement the Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention Program; and (2) authorize the Health Officer to sign subsequent amendments with the California Department of Public Health for the Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention Program that do not increase the level of General Fund support for the Division.

DISCUSSION

The three-year renewal agreement with the California Department of Public Health for the Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention Program (CLPPP) is a state funded program that provides outreach and education to individuals, health care providers and community partners. The CLPPP focus is on increasing awareness regarding the hazards of lead exposure, reducing lead exposure and increasing the number of children assessed and appropriately blood tested for lead poisoning. The CLPPP program offers home visitation, environmental home inspections and nutritional assessments to families of children found to be severely lead-poisoned. The CLPPP provides telephone contacts and educational materials to families of lead-poisoned and lead-exposed children. The CLPPP provides information and education to the general public, medical providers and community-based organizations.

The CLPPP program is comprised of a Public Health Nurse, Registered Environmental Health Specialists, Public Health Nursing Supervisor and Administrative support staff. These employees work as a team to provide health education through presentations and health fairs to the general public, health care providers and community based organizations.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT

County Counsel has approved the agreement as to form and legal effect.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

The agreement includes maximum funding in the amount of \$180,131 for Fiscal Year 2011-12 through Fiscal Year 2013-14. The allocation represents available funding in the amount of \$57,877 for FY 2011-12, \$64,377 in FY 2012-13 and \$57,877 in FY 2013-14. The FY 2011-12 budget includes \$57,877. Approval of this agreement will not increase the level of General Fund support required by the Public Health Department.

RESULTS

Outreach activities will be conducted through an email contact list to inform partner agencies and interested individuals about items with high levels of lead in products that become known in U.S. markets, such as children's jewelry or pottery.

Case management will be performed on all cases of children in San Luis Obispo County who have been reported to have a high lead level in their blood. In FY 2011-12 to date there have been two cases reported in San Luis Obispo County; prior to this fiscal year there were no reported cases in the last four years.

The CLPPP program is in direct alignment with the San Luis Obispo Public Health Department's mission to promote, preserve and protect the health of all San Luis Obispo County residents through disease surveillance, health education, direct services, and health policy development.
