SUBJECT: Submittal of a resolution establishing the 2012-13 Special Tax Rate and confirming the per parcel special tax amount in County Service Area No. 21, Madison Street Road Improvement Zone.

RECOMMENDATION

It is our recommendation that your Honorable Board:

1. Approve the resolution confirming the 2012-13 County Service Area No. 21, Madison Street Road Improvement Zone special tax rate of \$21.48 per front foot of improvement per parcel having a separate County Assessor's Parcel Number and increasing not more than two percent per year thereafter.
2. Direct the Clerk to file the approved copy of the resolution with the County Auditor no later than August 10, 2012.

DISCUSSION

On March 7, 2006, the electorate in County Service Area No. 21, Madison Street Road Improvement Zone voted for approval of a special tax with a maximum annual rate of Thirty Four Dollars and Fifteen Cents (\$34.15) per front foot of improvement per parcel having a separate County Assessor's Parcel Number and increasing not more than two percent per year thereafter. Fiscal Year 2012-13 will be the sixth year that the tax will be levied, which will continue until the loan is paid in full. No further consideration due to Proposition 218 is required.

In order to levy the tax during the 2012-13 fiscal year, your Honorable Board must pass a Resolution establishing the 2012-13 rate, and confirming the amount of the special tax levied on each parcel of real property. The special tax is authorized per Section 53978 of the Government Code.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT

County Counsel has reviewed the subject Resolution and approved it as to legal form and effect. The Offices of the Auditor-Controller and Treasurer/Tax Collector are involved in the process of collecting special taxes on the property tax bills. The County Clerk will file the resolution with the Auditor-Controller.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

The recommended action will generate approximately \$8,200 in revenue, which will fund the annual loan debt payment to the General Fund. The loan funded the paving of Madison Street.

RESULTS

The funds being paid back were originally used to pave Madison Street in Cambria. This has enhanced the quality of life for those participating in the project.
