RECOMMENDATION

DISCUSSION

First sponsored in 1958, National Library Week is a national observance sponsored by the American Library Association (ALA) and celebrated by libraries across the country annually during the second week of April. It is a time to celebrate the contributions of our nation's libraries and librarians and to promote library use and support.

Today, public libraries can help people discover a new and exciting world by offering much more than the traditional book. Library patrons now have free access to e-books, Wi-Fi, DVD's, CD's and video games. In addition to a wide collection of materials, libraries offer free year-round programs including book discussions, crafts, music events, reading programs for all ages, and movie nights.

Library staff and supporters respectfully request that your Board join the nation and the State of California in honoring libraries during the week of April 8-14, 2012 and encourage County citizens to take advantage of their local library's valuable resources.
