

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

### To the CONTRACT FOR BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES COUNTY OF SAN LUIS OBISPO BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES

Entered into by and between the County of San Luis Obispo, a public entity in the State of California, hereafter "County" and Community Action Partnership of San Luis Obispo, Inc., a California corporation, hereafter "Contractor"

**WHEREAS**, on October 3, 2011, the County and Contractor entered into a contract for fiscal year 2011-12 (the "Contract") under which Contractor agreed to provide certain services under the Mental Health Services Act;

**WHEREAS**, on October 25, 2011, the County adopted a Public Safety Realignment Implementation Plan (the "Plan") in response to Assembly Bill 109;

**WHEREAS**, the County and Contractor have a need to amend the Contract to add certain services related to the Plan and increase the maximum compensation under the Contract.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the parties agree that the Contract is amended as follows:

1. Exhibit A, "Scope of Services", is amended to add the following paragraph:

**4) Case Management Services for the Collaborative Reentry Program – 2011 Public Safety Realignment (also known as AB 109) (\$36,235)**

- a) Scope of Services: Contractor will provide the case management services as outlined below to support the County's 2011 Public Safety Realignment Implementation Plan as adopted by the Board of Supervisors, October 25, 2011.
- b) Service Specifications:
  - 1) In partnership with members of the Re-entry Team, screening, assessment and brief interventions conducted at a minimum of 90 days pre-release by the CAPSLO Case Manager to determine post-release needs (such as housing, employment, and other social service needs).
  - 2) In partnership with members of the Re-entry Team, development of an integrated transition case plan based on screening and assessment.
  - 3) Provide any in-custody brief interventions and preparation services needed prior to the release of the inmate (examples: housing applications, application for SSI, appointments for services).
  - 4) Conduct 'warm handoff' to the community based organizations. This includes limited case management

- work in the community with the offender until the handoff has been made to other social services.
- 5) May provide the offender access to transportation through provision of bus passes and other transportation options based on available resources.
  - 6) Participate in collaborative Re-entry Team case management meetings, and other agency meetings as needed.
  - 7) Work collaboratively with all Realignment partners, including but not limited to: Probation, Sheriff, Jail custody, Drug and Alcohol Services, Mental Health, and Court.
  - 8) In partnership with all Realignment partners, keep up to date information and work to develop the community resources needed for successful transition of the offenders.
- c) Staffing:
    - 1) 1.0 Case Manager
  - d) Units of Service:
    - 1) Units Defined:
      - i. Unique Client = Unique offender receiving case management services during fiscal year.
    - 2) Estimated monthly units: Contractor will report actual results each quarter and report results within 30 days of quarter end.
      - i. 25 – 30 unique offenders served per month.
2. Exhibit B, "Compensation" - Paragraph 1. Subparagraph b. is deleted and replaced in its entirety with the following:
    - b. The maximum amount of this contract shall not exceed three hundred one thousand nine hundred ninety-five dollars (\$301,995). All payments under this Contract must directly support services specified in this Contract.
  3. In any instance in which a provision of this Amendment No. 1 contradicts or is inconsistent with provisions of the Contract, the provision of this Amendment No. 1 shall prevail and govern and the contradicted or inconsistent provision shall be amended accordingly. All other terms and conditions of the Contract and any amendments shall remain in full force and effect.
  4. The effective date of this Amendment No. 1 shall be January 1, 2012.
