RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board approve a resolution proclaiming April 2012 as "National County Government Month" in San Luis Obispo County.

DISCUSSION

National County Government Month (NCGM) is celebrated each April by the nation's counties to raise public awareness and understanding about the roles and responsibilities of county government. The 2012 theme is "Healthy Counties, Healthy Families," which coincides with the National Public Health Week (NPHW) theme of "A Healthier America Begins Today. Join the Movement!" which is celebrated the first week of April.

The County is celebrating these two national events through a public outreach campaign to raise community awareness about the local resources available to our residents to help them live healthier lives. At the center of this campaign is the Gateway to Health, an online portal created by the Public Health Department, to provide our community with convenient access to a broad collection of both public and private resources within the county. The goal of the Gateway to Health is to inspire, inform, and support our residents in making healthy lifestyle choices for themselves and their families. All members of the community, as well as county personnel, are invited to use the Gateway to Health, which may be found at www.slopublichealth.org, under the Gateway to Health icon.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT

The Health Agency consulted two other County agencies (Parks and the Agricultural Commissioner) to include their program links on the Gateway to Health webpage, and contacted 11 local, community-based organizations.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

There are no financial considerations associated with the approval of this resolution.

RESULTS

Adoption of this resolution and promotion of the Gateway to Health supports the County's efforts to ensure all people in our community enjoy healthy, successful and productive lives, and have access to the basic necessities.
