SUBJECT: Submittal of a resolution commending Chief Deputy Ron Hastie upon his retirement with over 31 years with the County of San Luis Obispo. All Districts.

### **RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the Board adopt the attached resolution commending and thanking Chief Deputy Ron Hastie upon his retirement from the County of San Luis Obispo (County) with over 31 years of service to the residents of the County.

### **DISCUSSION**

Chief Deputy Ron Hastie began his career as a Correctional Officer with the Sheriff's Office in July 1987. Ron promoted to the position of Deputy Sheriff in March 1988 and attended the San Bernardino County Sheriff's Academy. Upon graduation Ron worked as a patrol deputy, bailiff and as a member of the Sheriff's Special Enforcement Detail (SWAT). In January 1994 Ron was promoted to Senior Deputy and was assigned as a Field Training Officer for new recruits assigned to the Sheriff's Coast Station in Los Osos.

In January 1995 Ron was promoted to Sergeant and assigned to the Operations Bureau where he worked for 12 years. During his tenure as a Sergeant, Ron worked as a Watch Commander, North Station Commander, Narcotics Unit Sergeant and Detective Sergeant. As the Detective Sergeant Ron supervised the investigations of major crimes, sexual assaults, deaths falling under the jurisdiction of the Coroner and the operations of the Sheriff's Crime Lab. During his assignment as a Detective Sergeant, Ron was responsible for securing grant funding that allowed for the creation of the Sexual Assault Felony Enforcement Team (S.A.F.E.) whose mission is to protect citizens from violent sex offenders by monitoring and ensuring that registered sex offenders comply with California law.

In March 2007 Ron was promoted to Sheriff's Commander. During his tenure as a Sheriff's Commander Ron was assigned as the commander of the Headquarters' Division, where he was responsible for the management of the Sheriff's Communications Center. He was then assigned to the Detective Division where he commanded all investigative units of the Sheriff's Office, including the Narcotics Unit and the County Gang Task Force. As a Commander, Ron was responsible for bringing patrol communications into the 21st Century by researching and managing the implementation of Mobile Data Computers in all the Sheriff's marked patrol units. This advancement allowed deputies in the field to access information previously only available to them from an office computer. This

technological advancement made Sheriff's patrol deputies more efficient and improved their ability to protect the citizens of the County.

In March 2015 Ron was promoted to Sheriff's Chief Deputy. As Chief Deputy, Ron has overseen the both the Operations Bureau, responsible for all patrol operations countywide and the Support Services Bureau, responsible for all investigative functions, all personnel matters including recruitment, training and citizen complaints. Ron has also been responsible for assisting Sheriff Parkinson in planning for the future of the Sheriff's Office by forecasting law enforcement needs in personnel, training, equipment and facilities to meet the needs of a diverse and growing county population.

Ron is the second member of the Hastie family to have achieved the rank of Sheriff's Chief Deputy, having followed his father, Chief Deputy John Hastie into public service with the San Luis Obispo County Sheriff's Office. Between Ron and his father there has been a member of the Hastie family on duty at the Sheriff Office, ensuring the safety of the public, for over 50 years.

Ron embodies the standard for a San Luis Obispo County Deputy Sheriff through his dedication and commitment to protect the residents of San Luis Obispo County. His contributions to the Sheriff's Office will have a long and significant impact on the safety of the residents of the County for many years to come.

Chief Deputy Ron Hastie has worked closely and collaboratively with many County departments and outside agencies throughout his years of dedicated service.
