SUBJECT: Submittal of a resolution authorizing the Sheriff-Coroner to enter into contracts with local agencies for use of the Sheriff's Firearms Range. All Districts.

### **RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the Board approve a resolution authorizing the Sheriff-Coroner to enter into contracts with local agencies for the use of the Sheriff's Firearms Range.

### **DISCUSSION**

For years the Sheriff's Office has entered into "Range Use Agreements" with other local, state and federal law enforcement agencies, allowing access to the Sheriff's range to facilitate weapons training and firearms qualifications for those law enforcement agencies not having access to their own range.

During use of the Sheriff's range facility, each permitted agency provides a qualified range master or certified firearms instructor to conduct all firing and training and to act as a supervisor and safety officer over the range and its activities. Each permitted agency also provides its own training materials and is required, by agreement, to follow all rules and regulations required by the Sheriff's Office, and to hold harmless and indemnify the County and its officers and employees against all claims.

When reviewing and updating these agreements, County Counsel recommended that the following modifications be made: a requirement of presentation of proof of insurance by the permitted agencies, and the Sheriff-Coroner should seek Board approval to enter into these agreements due to the inherent dangers involved in the training and use of firearms.

### **OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT**

County Counsel reviewed and approved the resolution as to form and legal effect.

## **FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS**

Approval of this resolution does not result in financial impacts to the County.

## **RESULTS**

The continued use of the Sheriff's Office Range facility by authorized local, state and federal law enforcement agencies provides them the ability to train and qualify their officers and agents in the proper, safe handling and use of firearms and other safety equipment.
