SUBJECT: Request to approve an agreement with VFW Post 10978 Nipomo allocating \$2,100 from District Four and Five Community Project Funds - Fund Center #106 to be used for the 4th of July parade in Nipomo. District 4 and 5.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of Supervisors approve the allocation of \$2,100 from District Four and Five Community Project Funds – Fund Center #106 to VFW Post 10978 Nipomo which will be used for expenses associated with the 4th of July parade in Nipomo.

DISCUSSION

The VFW Post 10978 of Nipomo's goal is to help local veterans and their families by providing assistance when needed. One of the services they provide is to provide safe, reliable transportation services for local veterans as many veterans are not able, or cannot afford, to travel within the County on their own. In addition, they sponsor and support events that help to further their mission of providing assistance to veterans. The VFW is sponsoring the first annual 4th of July parade in Nipomo. At the end of the parade there will be community BBQ. The event will focus on local veterans and their families and to celebrate our country's beginnings.

The \$2,100 in County funds will be used towards expenses associated with holding the parade on the 4th of July including, but not limited to, marketing, advertising, portable bathrooms, decorations, road signs and barriers.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT/IMPACT

VFW Post 10978 in Nipomo will do all the planning and coordinating of the event.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

Funding in the amount of \$2,100 will be allocated from Community Project Funds – Fund Center #106 to the VFW Post 10978 in Nipomo.

RESULTS

Funds will be used for expenses associated with holding the 4th of July parade including expenses such as marketing, advertising, decorations, road signs and barriers. This event will focus on honoring local veterans and their families.
