RECOMMENDATION

DISCUSSION

In an effort to help inform the public, County employees, local officials, State and Federal agencies, and partner agencies, the County produces an annual report every year. For the first time since the County began producing an annual report in 2010, the County's 2018-19 Annual Report focuses on activities that occurred in the fiscal year rather than the calendar year. This more closely aligns with the County's operations and budget development.

This year's annual report theme is "Ideas into Action," which demonstrates the County's results-oriented and responsive culture.

All County departments contributed to the production of this year's annual report to highlight specific accomplishments within different areas of interest. The report can only be found online at www.slocountyannualreport.com and is broken out into five sections: Public Protection, Healing & Wellness, Land & Environment, Community, and Good Governance. Each section contains a mix of articles, infographics, and videos for an interactive and engaging experience.
