SUBJECT: Request to reappoint Tony R. Hoffman to the San Luis Obispo County Workforce Development Board. All Districts.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board approve the reappointment of Tony R. Hoffman to the Workforce/Labor – Union Representative seat on the San Luis Obispo County Workforce Development Board (WDB). The seat term for Tony R. Hoffman will expire on June 30, 2023.

DISCUSSION

On July 22, 2014, the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) was signed into law and is designed to strengthen and improve the public workforce system and put job seekers back to work by helping workers acquire the skills employers need and help employers access the talent pool needed to compete in a global economy.

The WIOA mandates that the Chief Local Elected Official (CLEO) designate a local Workforce Development Board (WDB) to set policy direction and to oversee WIOA funded operations. The composition of the WDB is dictated by section 107 of the WIOA which specifies business, local education, local labor, economic development, and other mandated partner membership categories with business comprising the majority of members. The WDB currently has two seat vacancies which are detailed below:

Efforts to achieve full membership for the WDB are ongoing and include outreach to the building trades unions to fill the remaining vacancy. This item recommends one applicant for reappointment to fill a Local Workforce/Labor Union seat, leaving one remaining vacancy in a Local Workforce Labor/Union seat. The WIOA requires representatives from Local Workforce/Labor Union to be included in the local WDB membership. Tony Hoffman has worked in the Building Construction & Design industry since 1967. He retired in 2011 after 30 years as an elected Union officer for the Tri-Counties Labor Council. Therefore, Tony Hoffman is recommended for reappointment to one Local Workforce/Labor Union seat on the WDB.
