On behalf of our client, the landowner and applicant for the above referenced Minor Use Permit (MUP), Nouel Riel Cellars, Inc., we submit this letter requesting that the Board rescind its August 13, 2019, approval of the MUP. The Project is no longer economically viable due to the loss of the previously intended lessee of the site and the inability to secure a future lessee due, in part, to the current economic uncertainty in California's legal cannabis market.
